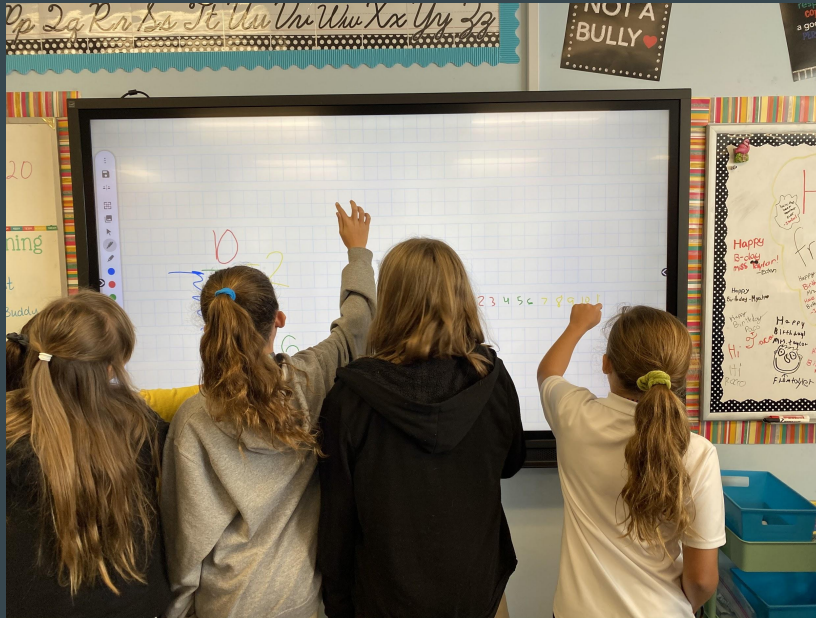

MATH

- + Ends "Confusing/Crazy Math" that was a roadblock for parents to help students at home
