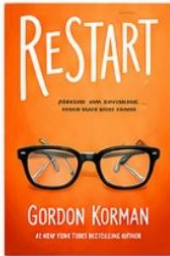


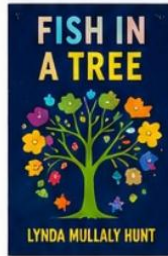

Choose a biography that inspires you! Learn about amazing people who changed the world.

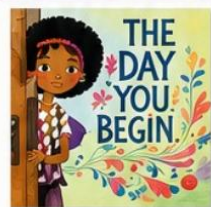

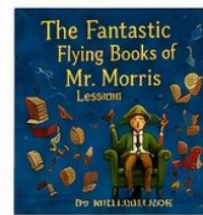
**9. The Day You Begin**
